S.A. Secedes From Commonwealth

L.C.L. POWER GRAB SHOCK

ADELAIDE, Today: It is believed by official sources that the Premier (Sir Thomas Playford) will formally announce the secession of South Australia from the Commonwealth today.

Bitter fighting has been reported along the Victorian border when South Australian troops infiltrated Commonwealth lines in gun-carriages disguised as John Martin's Procession floats.

At a press conference after the Premier's return from a recent Loan Council meeting, Sir Thomas declined to comment on the alleged proposed declaration of South Australia as an independent nation.

Observers observing the Premier's departure from the West Beach Airport, claim that before boarding the official steam-roller, he was heard to mutter sounds resembling "that bleeding batlub Menzies!"

Official sources have suggested that a somewhat strained relationship may exist between the Premier and the Prime Minister (Mr. Menzies).

Later, in Parliament, when asked by the Leader of the Opposition (Mr. Walsh), if there was any truth in the rumour that South Australia was to become an independent nation, the Premier replied that he was not in complete acquaintance with the situation, but Members could be assured that the Government was in complete control.

When reporters later attempted to interview Mr. Walsh they were informed that he had left Adelaide for Port Augusta, where he will assume control of the Electricity Trust's munitions plant in that area.

It is understood from official sources that the now vacant Downer residence will be used to house Dr. Castro during his goodwill mission to South Australia next year.

The Premier, now dictator, and his followers will drop their titles for the grand tour.

A high ranking Commonwealth Government official was apprehended at the Victorian border last night by members of the Playford

Blackshirts who have been annexing the River Murray. He was in the act of scaling the new 6 ft. border wall and attempting to smuggle secret information out of the State concerning a proposed revision of the electoral boundaries.

The contents of these documents are not yet known, but Government officials have revealed that they possibly concern the proposed revision of Sir Thomas' electorate, which is to be extended to include all districts bounded by the southern coastline, the West Australian, Victorian and Northern Territory borders.

When asked to comment on the proposed revolution today, the President of the Methodist Conference supported the coup, but said he would only continue to do so provided that fighting was discontinued on Sundays.

Representatives of other Churches supported Sir Thomas' move on the grounds that they did not support State aid to church schools. They believed that the Premier was in agreement with them.

The Archbishop of the Roman Catholic Church declined to comment from his fortress at Mt. Lofty.

New Element Discovered

Scientists throughout the world are elated by the discovery of a new element which they have already assigned the common name "Woman."

The accepted weight of the most abundant isomer (isomers are different forms of the same element) is 120 but rare ones are found between 65 and 400. The latter have an uninteresting and short half-life.

It is abundant in nature and can be found in both free and combined states, usually associated with an attacking species.

A number of different forms have been observed. Their transparency, hardness, colour and boiling point all vary within a wide range.

The colour exhibited by many specimens is only a surface phenomenon and is due to a closely adherent powder which can be scraped off by specialised techniques. Unpolished specimens tend to turn

Naturally occurring isomers have strong magnetic properties. The magnetic field strength varies inversely with the age. All isomers exhibit great affinity for silver, gold and platinum.

"Wm" surrounds itself with the elements in chain and ring forms. So great is Wm's appetite for these elements that it can be considered insatiable and very dangerous in the hands of inexperienced workers.

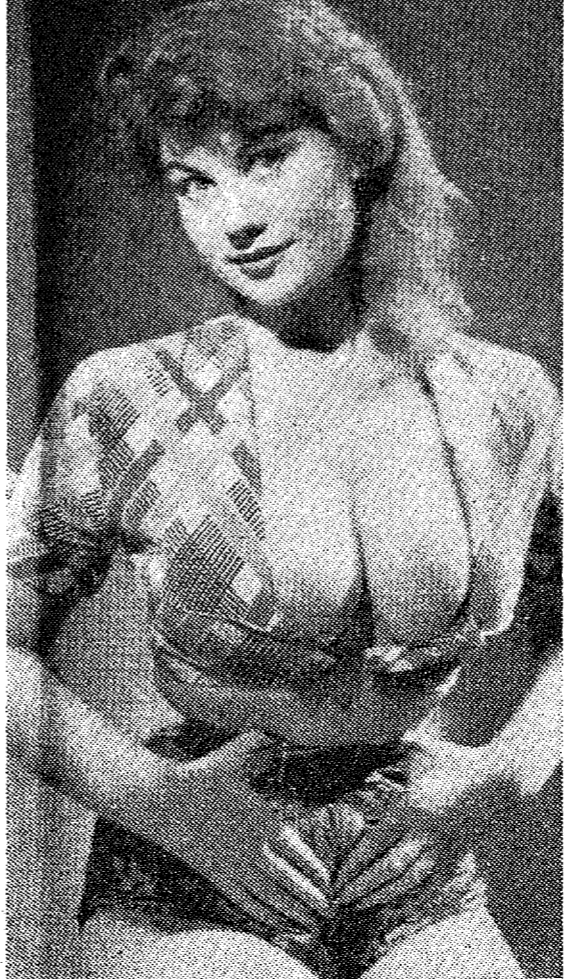
"Wm" can usually be reduced under mild pressure and gentle heating to a jelly-like substance which is quite explosive.

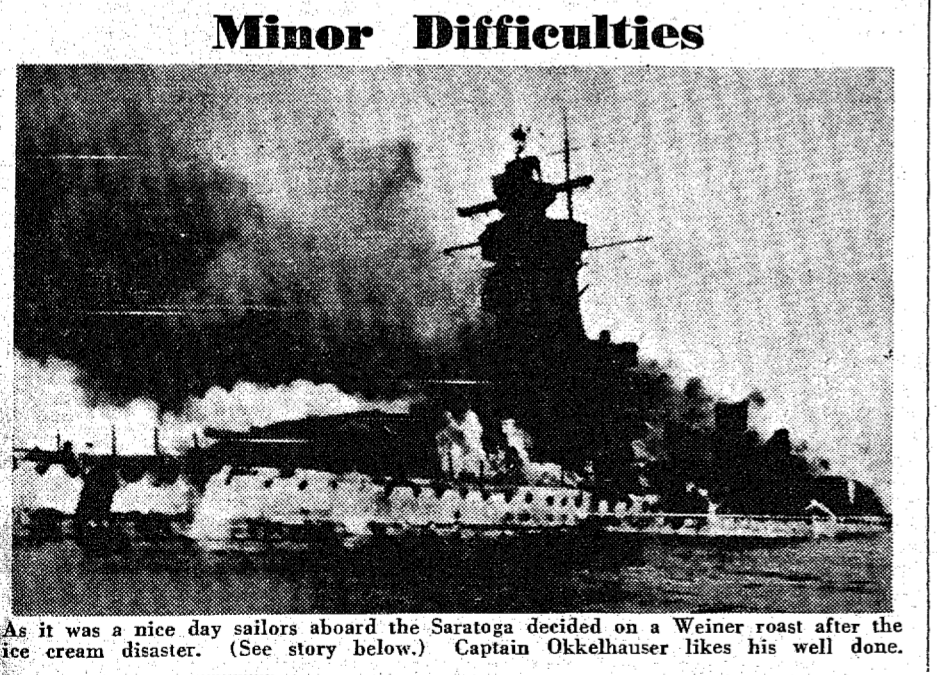

Minor Scuffle Off China Coast

Late this morning a report from the China Station confirmed our worst fears of unrest in the Formosan Area. Free Chinese claim an abortive attempt by Communists to cross the Quemoey channel has been repulsed with great losses (at present it is not clear which side sustained the great losses).

Communist sources have stated that the victorious People's Army is now pouring into Formosa after a clever feint to the Quemoey region had lured Nationalist forces away from the main sector.

The American Seventh Fleet stationed off Formosa went into action at dawn but reported no contact until an hour ago when the tenth wave of assault troops was intercepted. The other nine decided to stay home and play checkers as it was too

cold to go out and attack Formosa till the spring. The Super Carrier "Saratoga" had to be withdrawn from the fierce battle when a fanatic suicide charge by Communist row-boats disabled the ice cream machine and a stray bullet put every homogenised cigar lighter on board O.O.C.

American casualties are reported to be non-existent and the third Miami Beach Marine Division captured, after confused fighting and great deeds of valour, an undefended island off the Mainland China

(about 90 miles). General Carl Van Rommel who led the assault is reported to have said, "It was tough but we made it and now have a great base for our B-52's. Unfortunately all our B-52's are needed for the Air Force displays back home and so Australia is loaning the U.S. half a dozen Dakotas."

Meanwhile subsequent reports from the troubled area indicate either Formosa captured by Communists, China reconquered by Nationalists, America invaded from Mars

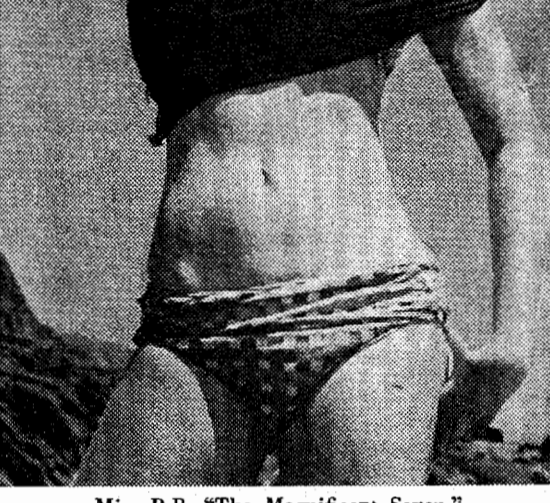

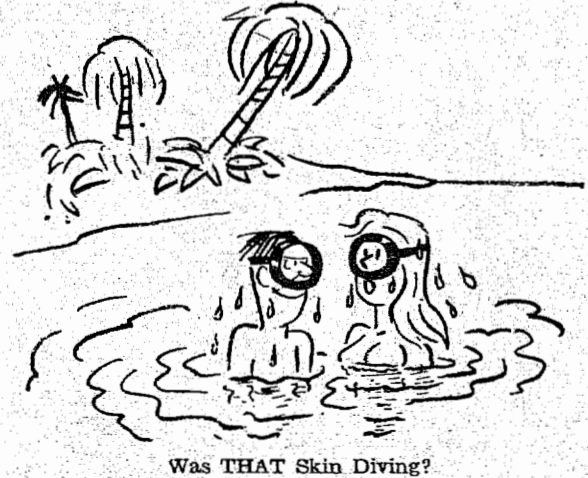

or that the situation is stable and only sporadic fighting is taking place. It seems almost certain that Communist troops effected a landing but reports indicate that at least one wave of assault troops was last seen rowing vigorously past the southern tip of Formosa out into the Pacific Ocean. This has caused alarm on the Pacific Seaboard in America and already the large cities of San Francisco and Los Angeles have been evacuated. The President has declared a state of National Emergency and has been in touch with the Heads of free countries in an attempt to raise a U.N. force to repel the invaders.

The President said, "As in World War II, we are ready to fight to the death (of all Australian soldiers)."

Back in Formosa Generalissimo Field Marshal Lance Civilian Chiang Kai Chek said he was pleased at the way the volunteer Nationalist Forces flocked to repel the invaders. He is quoted as saying "Naturally their first instinct was to run but soon they saw reason and returned to fling the enemy into the sea."

Landing Success

Communist sources state candidly that at least half the attacking soldiers conveniently landed in Malaya by mistake. People's General Bong said that the twenty-five million that landed has proved adequate for the attainment of a complete military victory. A carrier-borne strike by Seventh Fleet aircraft was enthusiastically described by General Osgood Z. Hamburger as "A bloody great success. When we got to the jumping off places for the Red Chinese troops we found they'd all left but we sure made one helluva mess of the sandhills and those beachies; we dropped all our dirty shirts. They do a tremendous job on the collars."

Fifteen aircraft failed to return and Washington demanded an immediate investigation concerning the twelve which were last seen heading for Surfers' Paradise. Apart from the Marines the only other U.S. troops in action to date were the

Fourteenth Arkansas Shin-back Fusiliers composed of Negro troops. They went into action at first light. General Louis Deepsouth on the tincan Mintjuley put down his neat bourbon and cheroot to say he was disappointed with their efforts as they were still five miles from Peking and had been fighting three hours. Reports have also come in concerning the use by the Reds of fiendish new weapons and it seems almost certain now that Nationalist troops in the Planta Planta area surrendered en masse to the People's Army Ninth Division (Generalissimo Shanghai Lil's women's division). They are now busy fraternising and trying for better relations.

Hungary

From the rest of the world various assurances have gone out to the conflicting powers involved. Premier Khrushchev, when told last night in the Kremlin of the impending attack, ordered troops to be rushed to the Berlin sector to make sure that the Chinese People's Army doesn't get carried away with its victories and "try marching in on us." He said he would do all in his power to keep the Communist world as it was a happy Utopia devoid of want and fear, and so saying immediately sent six armoured divisions to the Hungarian sector to reassure the people there. President Kennedy, apart from his attempt to raise the free world from its lethargy, spent the morning anxiously watching the stock exchange reports and calling his brokers.

In London, Prime Minister McMillan and Prime Minister Menzies of Australia were in conference at Lords and could not be drawn into making any statements apart from the fact that they each thought they had the best opening attack.

It seems almost certain that a request for U.N. troops will be granted and that the question of the recognition of China may have to be reviewed.

It is all beautifully confused.
