An interesting link with the past was severed by the death on Christmas morning of Mrs. Frances Mary Stow (widow of Mr. Justice Stow) at her home, St. Margaret's, Childers-street, North Adelaide. Mrs. Stow, who was born in Western Australia in 1836, was a daughter of the late Mr. Marshall MacDermott. Her father was for ten years a stipendiary magistrate in this State, and before coming to Australia held a captain's commission in the 8th King's Regiment. In 1857 he held the portfolio of Commissioner of Crown Lands in the South Australian Government. Mrs. Stow came to South Australia when 10 years of age, and was married at Christ Church, North Adelaide, in 1854, to Mr. Randolph Isham Stow, then a rising barrister. Her husband had a brilliant professional career, and became a Queen's counsel and a leader of the bar. He entered Parliament as a representative of West Torrens in 1861, and held the office of Attorney-General. He was elevated to the Supreme Court bench a little more than three years before his death on September 18, 1878, in his fiftieth year. Mrs. Stow had a wide circle of friends, for she was deeply beloved for her kindly nature and unflinching courtesy. After the passing of the Women's Suffrage Bill she took a deep interest in politics, and was an energetic worker. The franchise having been extended to her sex, she held it to be the duty of every woman who exercised the vote to acquaint herself as far as possible with politics. Mrs. Stow lived in North Adelaide for nearly 50 years, and endeared herself to her neighbors. She was an active and a sympathetic philanthropist, and did much good in her characteristically quiet way. She broke her hip joint about four years ago, and since then she had not been able to leave her home as freely as before, but she was able to get about until two years ago. She moved round in her own house, however, until the day of her death. The family are:—Mr. P. R. Stow, of Messrs. Bakewell, Stow, and Piper, solicitors; Mr. R. M. Stow, of York, Western Australia, solicitor; Dr. F. L. Stow, Crown Solicitor of Western Australia; Miss Stow, of North Adelaide; and Lady Creswell, wife of Rear-Admiral Sir W. R. Creswell.

COUNCIL MEETING.

A meeting of the council was held on Friday, January 22, at 3 p.m. There were present:—The vice-chancellor, Mr. Brookman, Mr. Isbister, Dr. Poulton, Mr. Talbot Smith, Dr. Hayward, Mr. W. J. Denny, Dr. Cairns, Dr. Helen Mayo, and Professor Mitchell. An apology for the unavoidable absence of the chancellor was received.

The annual report of the proceedings of the University for the year 1914, submitted by the Education Committee, was approved. The balance sheet and statement of accounts for 1914, submitted by the finance committee, were also approved. Mr. F. W. Young wrote resigning his position as a member of the council in view of his early departure for London to assume the office of Agent-General for this State. The resignation was accepted with regret.
