Mr. Colebatch's Withdrawal.

"Unfair Criticism."

Arising out of the appointment of the Principal of Roseworthy Agricultural College (Mr. W. J. Colebatch, B.Sc., M.R.C.V.S.) on the Rural Settlement Commission, adverse criticism of the Government's action was heard recently...

A TRAVELLING SCHOLARSHIP.

TO BE AWARDED TO A TEACHER.

A travelling scholarship, tenable for one year, of the annual value of £200, is to be awarded by the South Australian Education Department to a teacher who has shown special ability.

It may be awarded annually. Any teacher holding the scholarship may be awarded a second year. The scholarship is open to teachers of not less than 25 and not more than 40 years of age, provided that no teacher is eligible who has had less than five years' practical experience in teaching...

The scholar will be required to pursue a definite line of study or research in some branch of the theory, practice, or administration of education. During the tenure of the scholarship, the scholar must furnish brief monthly reports to the Director, and upon return to South Australia must present a thesis embodying the result of the year's study or investigation.
