My dear Henry,

I got your letter and enclosures on my return from Scotland. The letterpress for the museum material will I hope be printed early in October, and then be ready for rearrangement.

There is one detail still lacking from the sex data for this year, namely the subdivision of those released into males and females, e.g. I have for the 11th 63 captured, 40 male, 23 female, but of the 60 released at the same date I have not this subdivision. The same applies to the 18th, when 103 were released out of 104 captured. It is, of course only a small point, but if you have the actual figures, I had better use

them for explicit calculations.

I have been asked by Srygler to form a small committee on nomenclature in human genetics, and propose to ask Hather, yourself and Race. I do hope you will be willing to join with us in discussing proposals with the Americans and other national committees. I have of course stressed that I myself would favour discussion and advice rather than any coercive standardisation.
