Dear Prof. Gini,

I enclose a table of coefficients and a note on their use which I was led to prepare by Dr C. Jordan's interesting paper in volume 7 of "Metron" (Pt. 3, pp. 47-51) published in 1928.

I do not know whether Dr Jordan has himself prepared a table of coefficients in which case perhaps my table will not be needed. It has however been designed for use with tables of high accuracy and needing somewhat heavy interpolation and may be of increasing use as this type of material will probably increase in abundance.

The British Astronomical Union have asked me, in the event of your publishing my table and note, to obtain on their behalf, a quotation for the cost of 100 or 200 offprints in covers.
