I doubt if satisfactory could will easily be obtainable from wild populations they are worth collecting I think much more useful results would be obtained by planting out seedlings on an experimental open-pallinated plot for a succession of years say a thousand plants annually for five years using mixed seed to start with. Such a plot would have the advantage of providing good normal material as required from time to time if Genetical work were undertaken, I should be very glad if you would support the idea of growing such a plot at Merton but would certainly not wish to press the subject if Sir.Daniel feels in any reluctant.
