Dear Fisher,

As you know, I have been working on Dominance since 1920. Up to this year I have been obliged to place myself among those who opposed your theory of dominance but am now publishing a paper in J. Genet. in which I believe that I have provided a clear and unequivocal demonstration that the Fisher Effect does actually occur, and that it is the method by which dominance is established has been worked in 3 species of New World Coryphæus (hirsutus, pubescens, and taeniæ.) In the other 3 species the Haldane effect has been at work (use of a powerful Normal)

I enclose a copy of my discussion and take this opportunity of expressing my sincere admiration of the clear reasoning which led you to form your theory.
