Dear Dr. Linder,

Thanks for your letter ^{of} the direction and extent of dominance when data are available giving both parents of each child.

It is decidedly interesting that you have indications in the same direction as those which Dr. Gray and I found in Boas's data.

It would be interesting to survey your material further in case of more decisive dominance effects in respect of other measurements. I could not forecast which measurements are most likely to give clear evidence, save that quite evidently some human measurements are susceptible of greater relative accuracy than are others.
