Thanks for your letter and for your kind congratulations. I wonder if you ought not to try to see Adrian personally, or at least, to send him an offprint with photographs showing that you did report the rate of beat of the flagellum to be 12.7 per second on the basis of your experimental results. I suppose also Taylor did not advert to your result in finding this rate on apparently theoretical ground.

I do not suppose yours is the only complaint essentially against the refereeing system which the President will have received in recent times.

As you are in Peterborough I wonder if you would have time to come in and dine with me in College some time before you return to Plymouth.
