Dear Mather,

Thanks for your letter. I did not mean to suggest that you should tie yourself in London before October 1st. You might, however, well find it advantageous to master what is known about the stocks at once on arrival, so as to make sure that their subsequent treatment is not in your opinion either mistaken or unintelligible.

The reversal of dominance in *Antirrhinum* seems decidedly interesting. It would be good if we could arrange with Hall and Haldane at Merton to place some cultures there. I am not quite sure at present how they would react to the proposal.
