Thanks for sending me your letter to Nature. Of course, I think it is a good job. I am not wholly convinced of the significance of the pattern of + and - signs which you produce, since so much can be done with patience and ingenuity by rearrangement. This does not, of course, detract from the pedigree evidence of real allelomorphism. Could you not say

somewhere, if it happens to be true, that related D<sup>u</sup>d bloods from relatives always give identical reaction series; if not there may be some real allelomorphs and some bogus ones mixed with them?
