Dear Rob,

I have received your letter, a day or two after returning from the States, with the Australian Aborigines blood groups, but I cannot clearly understand what it all means. The first sheet lists 234 people, but the supplementary sheet says an extra 60 added to those which Graydon calculated and gives estimated gene frequencies on, it says, about 260. The extras are not, however, distributed in the observable phenotypes, of which I think there are 7. These I interpret as follows:

Before I look at them again let me know, if you will, if this is the interpretation you put on the table.
