Dear Professor Fisher,

At the last meeting of the Faculty of Science Library Sub-Committee it was suggested, on the recommendation of Miss Karn, that the second edition of your book, *The design of experiments*, should be purchased for the General Library under the heading of Biology.

The scientific books which have recently been purchased for the General Library have been in the interests chiefly of intermediate students, and the Committee was of the opinion that the book in question, if on the same lines as the first edition, was definitely of too advanced a character for the section of the Library in question.
