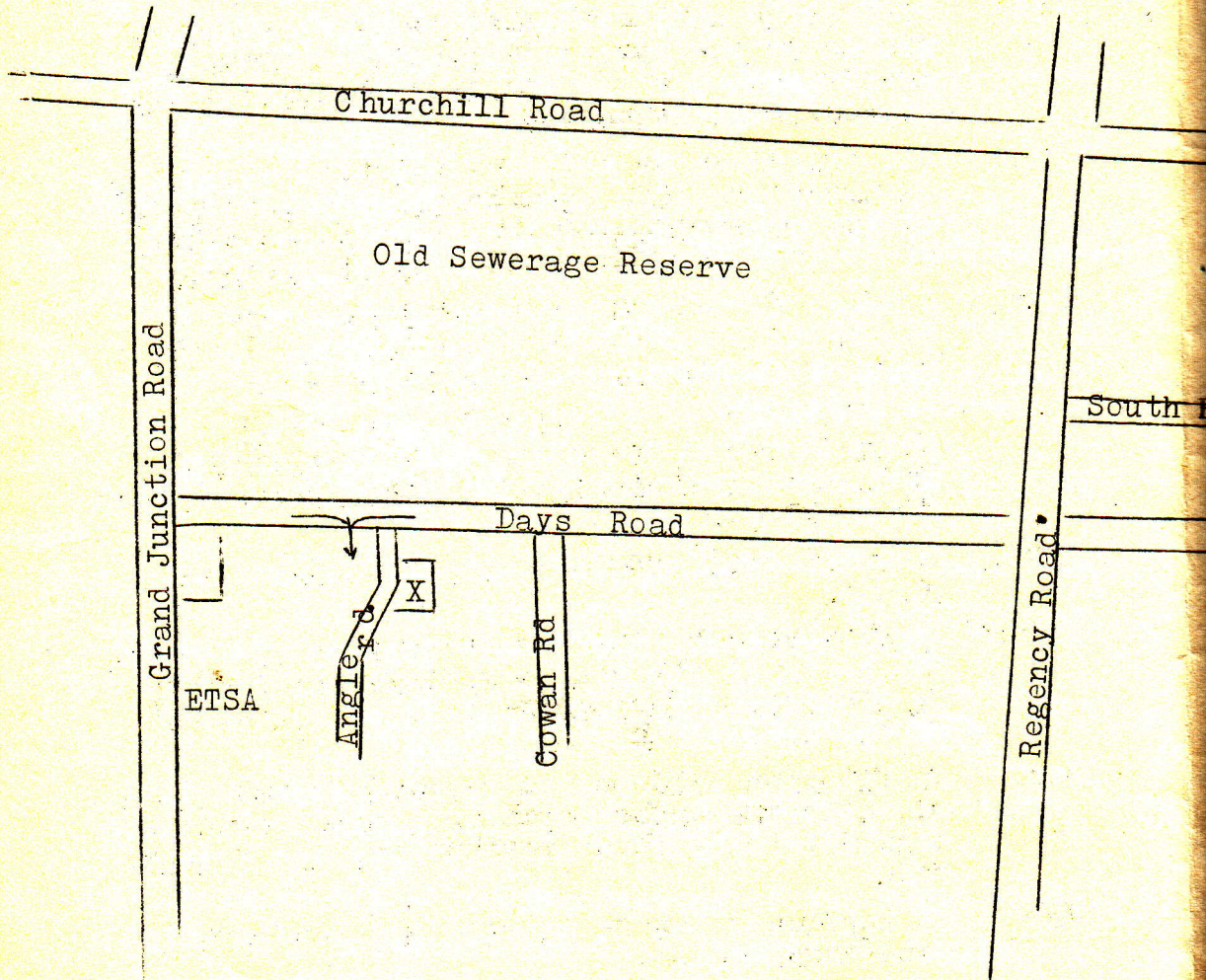
- (1) Pros and Cons of the Association becoming incorporated.
- (2) Notice of Motions
  - (a) "that the Association becomes an incorporated body"
  - (b) that the Constitution be changed to read :  
"Title - the Association to be called the  
Roseworthy Old Collegians Association  
Incorporated"
  - (c) Objective of R.O.C.A. be amended to include point 3 as set out below :
    - (i) To promote the interest of the College
    - (ii) To promote unity and good fellowship amongst Old Collegians
    - (iii) To stimulate and encourage members to develop their agricultural interest
    - (iv) To encourage discussion in matters relating to agriculture
- (3) Scholarship - Recommendations of the Sub-Committee.
  - (i) A Scholarship should be awarded annually to the value of \$300 unless in the opinion of the Selection Panel no suitable application has been received.



- (ii) It should be awarded to applicants who are thereby encouraged to develop interest related to agriculture
- (iii) To be eligible, an applicant must be a member of ROCA
- (iv) Preference shall be given to the applicant who shows the greatest promise of future achievement and the greatest benefit to the agricultural industry
- (v) The award can be used to reimburse expenses incurred provided application is made prior to the conclusion of the project or course of study for which assistance is sought.
- (vi) A panel to select the recipient of the scholarship should be formed, and it should consist of 7 members as follows :
  - The award of merit Selection Panel (four persons) President and Secretary of ROCA and the Principal or Vice Principal of the College.
- (vii) A quorum will consist of 5 members of the Panel.
- (viii) Application for the scholarship should be in the hands of the Honorary Secretary of ROCA by 31st May. The award is to be announced at the Annual Dinner.
- (ix) Application will not be carried forward into the next 12 months period. A new application should be made if a previous one was rejected.
- (x) No applicant can be awarded the scholarship more than once.
- (xi) That the successful applicant undertakes at the end of the project or course to supply a report, or address to ROCA at such times and places as may be mutually convenient.
