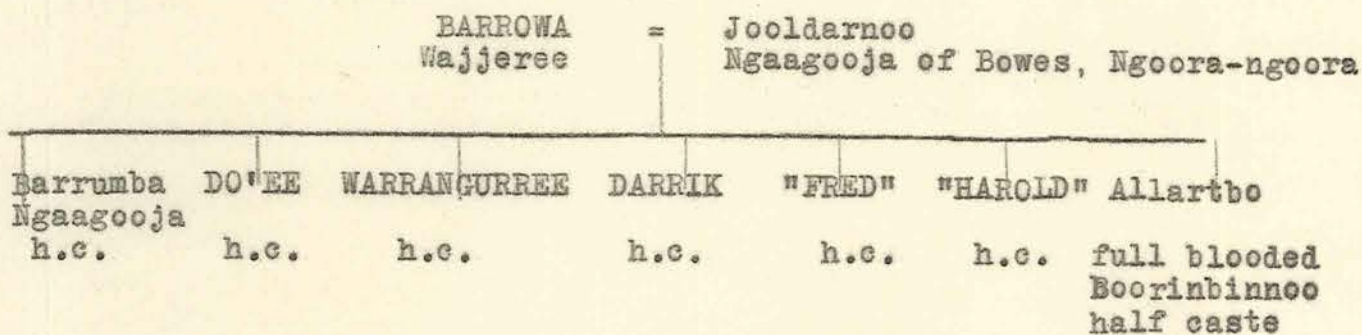

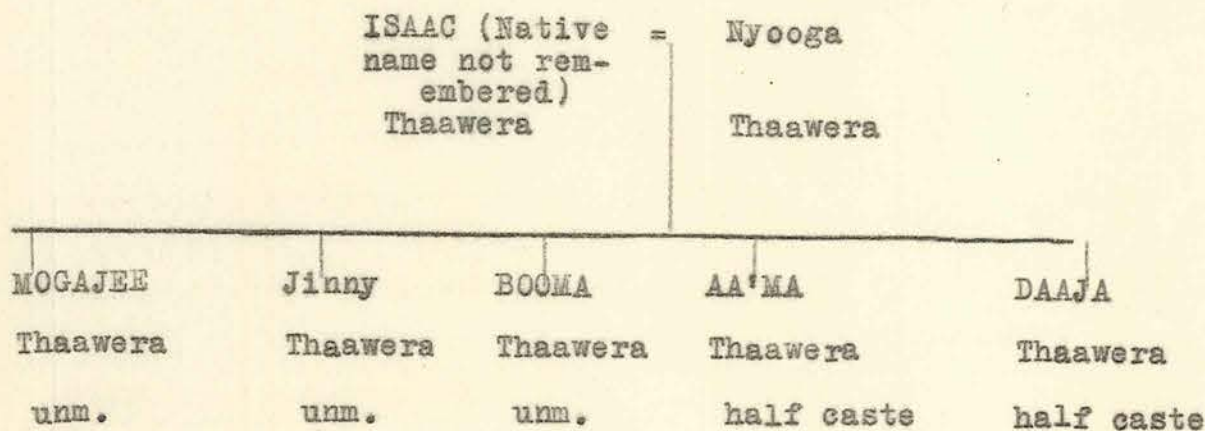

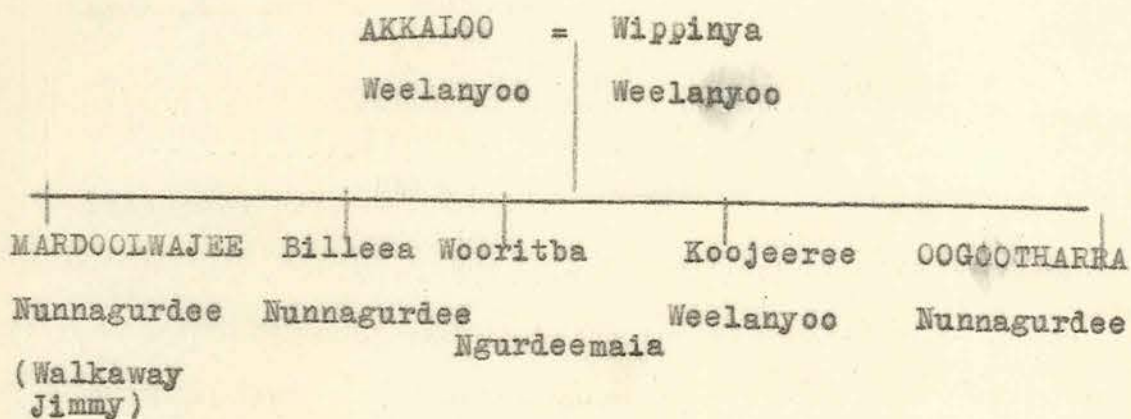

(The difference in these classes is owing to the children being taken away by their mothers to Ngurdeemaia, Weelanyoo, etc. It is a matter of etiquette to allow the children to be adopted into other tribes when thus taken away.)

At Nullagine the classes appear to be changed according to Kanmaringo, female, of Koorgangoonya (Nullagine River).

Kanmaringo's mother was Kaimera, her father Banaka. She is Paljari. She married MONGOODINGOO, a Boorongoo, and had one son, a Kaimera.

Wajjeera states that his people's marriage classes are as under :-

Boorong father, Kaimera mother, Paljari child
Kaimera father, Boorongoo mother, Boorgooloo child.
Boorgooloo father, Paljari mother, Kaimera child.
Paljari father, Boorgooloo mother, Boorongoo child.

Boorgooloo and Paljari are ngabbaroo to each other, and Kaimera and Boorongoo are also ngabbaroo.
