When Edeean had reached the age of puberty, Milbung took her also to wife. and lived with the second mother and daughter for some years.

Bardeet says woobaruk are the borungur too. Koitch's are made of mowern and are called koitch ngorlok maat (handle is made of baaluk) and the gum is baaluk beenk.

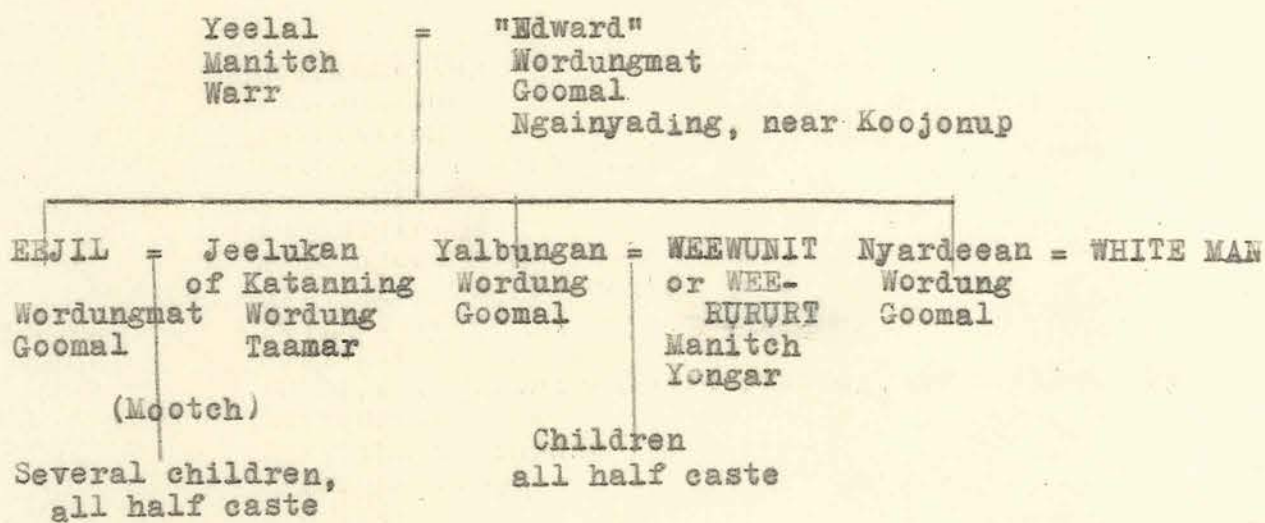
Yongar borungur cannot marry yongar borungur. They must marry some other totem. Manitchmat are yongar borungur. Wordungmat are wej and goomal. Kaiar and Darinyit's father saw a jaanuk, and he made the children jaanuk borungur. The ground was jaanuk boojoor.

At Wanderung there is (in the kaat at Bonkil) a waagul who sits down there. No strange noongar can go there.

Ar Daalungup is a winneejung gully, where the waagul sits down. Kalleepgur do not hurt booyungur.

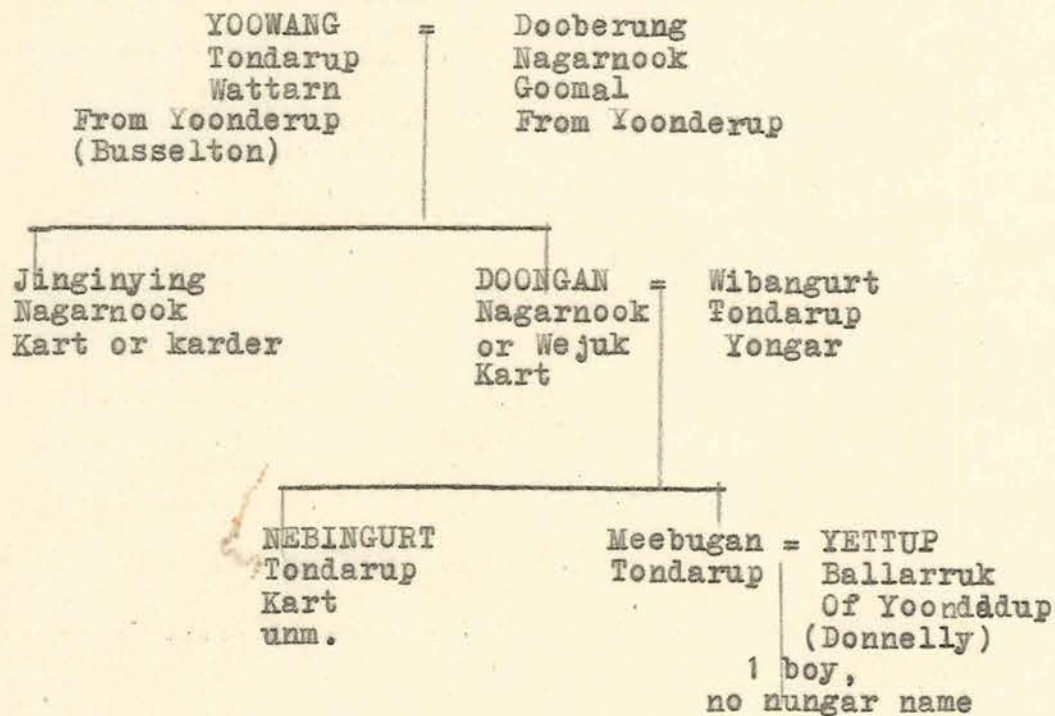
At Kεbugain is another gully where the waagul sits down, No kalleepgur are hurt at these places, only booyungur.

Marrain, f., of Walyeeba or Walyee beena (between Coolgardie and Norseman), had as daughter Windarree. Harvey mentions Walyeeba as being west of Coolgardie.

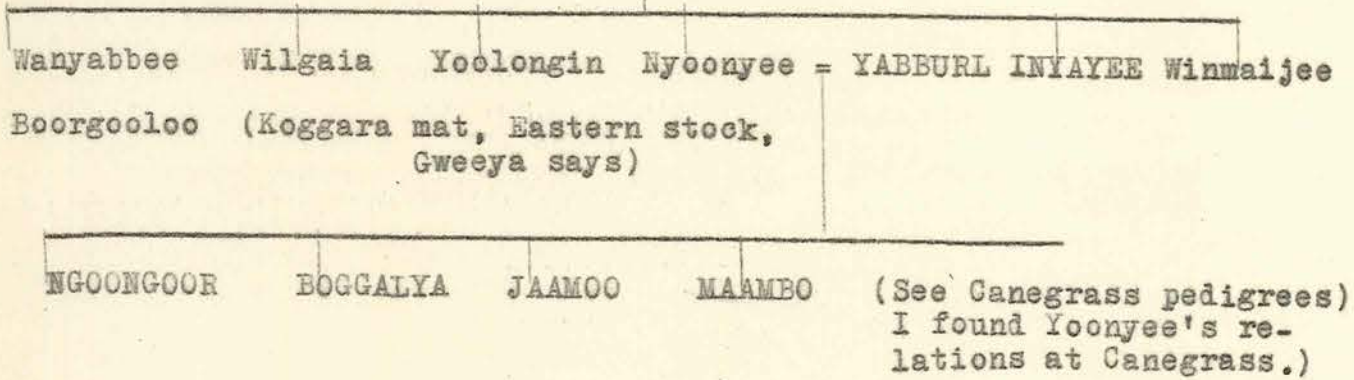

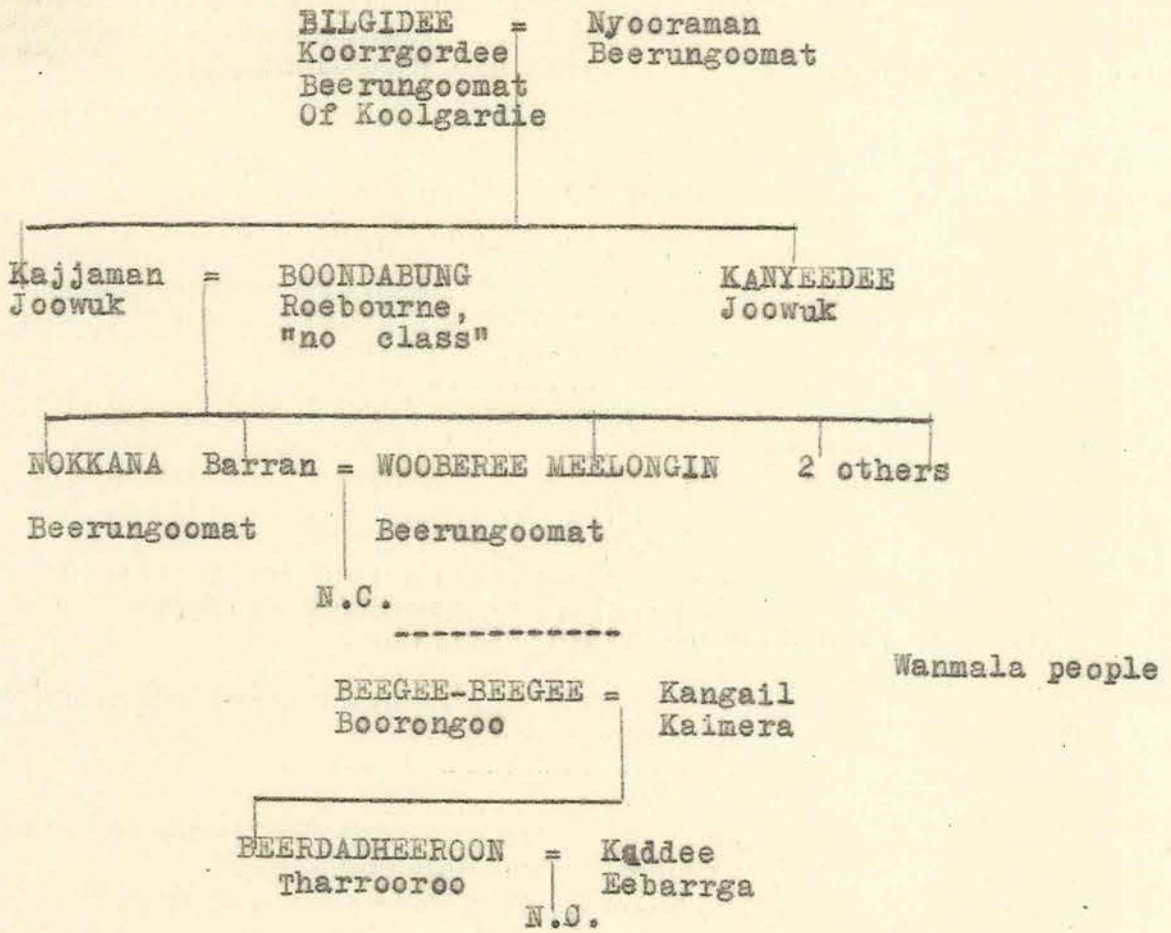

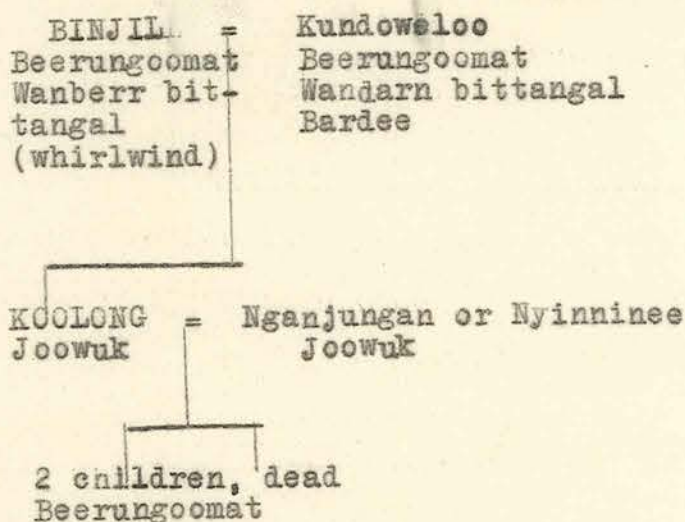

Namesakes are frequent at Southern Cross, as Kaddee's step daughter Kandoweloo has been named after Walloonee's step sister. The two Kandoweloo's are Beerungoomat, the present one should be Mimalla's (Gweeya's) wife, but the Broome man took her.

Gweeya and Bailberin yesterday thought that a little whirlwind which played close to their wammo (camp) came from me. Gweeya said he saw it come from the box I was sitting on.

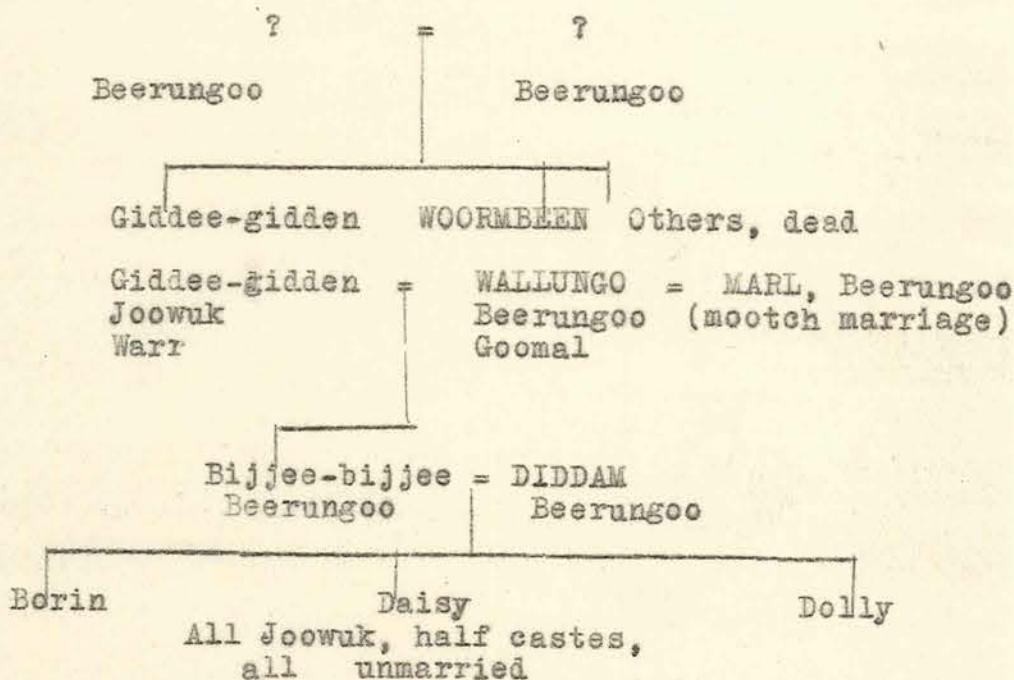
