of the Review of Hunders Marines in York Reflected as
given them as a reward for their good behaviour, their ~~officers~~ of help

at Princess Royal Harbour. ~~Left~~ ^(Arrived) Jan 1 - 1901 until

Immediately on his departure every man - young & old began to
recite the motions made by the Troops. The action of the
trumpets, the marching, the uniforms, & every motion was
remembered. As at the review they all recited many stories
about the Kings of Marines, so that every motion of Muskets
every tread of the Marines, Circles remembered & repeated
over & over. They believed Hunders this man was the Spirit of themselves
dead, returning from Karamup & see their old boojie (ghosts)
& go back to Karamup again. The dance was a Karamup dance
they gave their "local brothers" before they returned to Norway
The Yunger (man) saw likenesses between the crew & these poor
dead. There were no women on ship during the
ships stay ~~for~~. The fine character of Hunders & his
crew under his ~~instructions~~ behaviour splendid
brought the completeness of the review from
Hunders. The whole group remained

Debuting, began to go through every motion of the ~~the~~ ^{Heavenly} dance, again and again until every Nundebidjum dasham. They judged it among themselves & then they & their group, women included, kept apart from the men, because the dance was a Heavenly one, & no one had brought it to them. It was never an earthly dance & had no name other than Karamup Kening (Koora-Jerawg; up, place of ^{was between women}) (Koora-n-up). If the direction Flinders had given to the Indians, had also been intended, Debiningan cow at his Kating Camp (was, & being the oldest, greatest. I have his boughs near my own tent. 20th) & cows had been more frequently. ~~seen~~. It was the consequence of my keeping her away from the others all through the epidemic that he mentioned the Karamup Kening. I had spoken of the "Home of the dead," & the same Karamup Kening over their old name for the home of their dead beyond the western sea. They practiced the dance daily for weeks probably until all those who saw it knew it perfectly. There have been an uprising period for all their local ~~the~~ ^{Coastal natives} related groups were there Northern Vasse Skelton was found near Busselton & last was along the Southern Coast to somewhere near Eucla. Then they went north ^{up} towards Boundary Bay.

Borwari Dan was in their old Travelling Tralls Then they lost
their Special Dances. Wernawa is all round the State of Orissa.
They may have sold "ibabara" it to each group its Birds, &
its border they have been conducted only as Jackson's species or
Twilight Crows or at some place not-jepew & the members of the
Borwari Dan & Guda were same as others but
Lie. James says natives belonging to these Northern Groups -
including in Cambodians. Lie. Col. T. Jones in Lie. Col. Guda area the
very living native & James denied that he had eaten human
meat, but the other Jellors "did".

The Karamup dance kept its heavenly name as far East-Loca
along the Southern Coast as Twilight Crows & T. Jones is the
leader Cape dever.

there were no first class marriages forbidden by either the two
class group or the four class. This is Federal descent.
The certain punishment for a breach of this law,
A Crow married a White Cockatoo, the children were Crows.
A Cockatoo married a Crow. The children were crows.
In the 4 class division South of Burdettor. The Crow
was despised.
