1902-10 Working among the descendants of Presb. New Guinea Guigui Albany, Esperance. The Eastern & Western - areas - other goldfields, Broome & Port Darwin - areas - obtaining their local pronunciation dialects - genealogies - names of places - & especially their vocabularies & local customs etc. diseases - such as pleurisy etc. Superintendent's Island Lock Hospitals - ~~the~~ & investigation into matters connected therewith. As a result of my ~~report~~ reports & suggestions to the then Govt. - these hospitals were closed down.

1911. at. Catacumbe Camp - an epidemic of measles gave rise to patients to tend with no hospital facilities - no tents, no nurses etc. The epidemic was rapid among the white people of the township & no help could be given me. However none of my measles patients died. The white population children & adults succumbed daily.

1912. Gas of Albany - Ravensthorpe, Esperance etc. & then on to Quela. to Balladonia & Dampier.

1912-14. Quela & ~~Balladonia~~ areas. These records of the remaining descents were secured before they expired.

1914. visited Pt. via Nullarbor Plain. to attend Census Camp of which I was an Australian member, & Guest of Hostels.

1914-18. Investigation ~~of~~ ^{of} all descents of the Quela & Bight areas - ~~Lowest~~ & Streaky Bays - & descents from Boundary Dam - Olden - & other areas north of the Great Nullarbor Plain. (The Centre of the plain was never crossed by natives until led from the Bay to the Margaret Water (North edge of Plain) & Chichester Basin are Gullashinan & dwellers of Quela for health reasons for many years. A great friend of the natives & a great & fine Englishman.

1918. Conditions ~~existing~~ existing on the G-W Line
(which had been given in 1917) called for Service
in the Doldra area. Doldra having been
known to the aborigines as a permanent & abundant
water for thousands of generations & for over
a thousand mile radius. Doldra
my ~~present~~ work ~~there~~ ~~was~~ ~~from~~ ~~1918~~
later from 1918 till 1935. I remained at the
same camp. & during those years ~~of~~ I have
to record that, not one halfpenny was
befallen at ~~the~~ by Doldra Camp. This fact
became known to the passengers on the G-W
Trains & Churches - Government, Tourists, etc.
& the knowledge passed on to England -
America - ~~has~~ ~~been~~ ~~investigation~~. The
