Dr Capell, a German from Dresden, has come out on some 'mission' service to the "Dresden Pallottine Mission" that took over the quiet Trappist Mission Field at Beagle Bay. All were Germans who took over. They had come from some African German Pallottine Order to settle at Beagle Bay. Dr Capell arrived from the continent or London in 1829 [1929?] and at once went to the Dresden Mission at Beagle Bay.
