LETTERS MEAN LIT

Registration as Protection

"The registration of music teachers in South Australia is a protection which parents ought to be able to obtain from the Government," said Mr. H. G. Robinson, vice-president of the Elder Conservatorium.

"We have tried at different times to effect this, but as the Government has not been sympathetic, the subject is always brought up at the conferences of the Australian Musical Examination Board, which is the body which conducts music examinations in the State of the Commonwealth, and rightly should lead the way in a question of such importance..."

LETTERS AN OBSESSION

"The possession of letters after a man does not constitute ability to teach any subject, but it has always been insisted upon in which competent teachers without an allegedly magic letters have been ignorantly selected for the schools..."

"Examinations, success in which entitles candidates to subscribe their names with an address to letters, are held in this profession solely by many, and 'The Musical Times,' London, has recently been speaking emphatically against the possession of such letters..."
