I returned from my doctor's office - & established
myself again among my relatives - but I think I have
sent many a little atomic thought to you & can well
wondering how you were faring in these dreadful
times of scarcity in Adelaide & Washington much
& have you here with me. There there is plenty of
food which I cannot eat - sitting here by myself
Are you well? have you been well? I went to Fowler
Bay & can you believe it! my babies - some of them
had "heard by snuff" I was coming up. & Percival & Hugh
& Inyagaji & some others near the 80 miles from Adelaide
& when the car came to Probst's (Koorabi) (a Mercedes
shopkeeper, drove me there from Fowler) they ran round
round the car their eyes streaming with joy, their clothes
to the car frightened the German woman, I think, but they
were so glad! & when a native of old he showed twice
as many teeth as he normally possesses! & just as
dress strunk into the corner of the car - so I got
out. & they did not even see the food in the car
that I had brought for them - Kabberk Kabbarli they
cried, yet - they did not touch me because their
hands may not have been clean I should have
known they would have marked the
my old Yuria campsite has been taken up by
Mrs Kress's husband I think, & so I could

not - see any more than I must have
 all area free from any kind of dirty people.
 My presenters quite understood that we could
 not go back to Yona camp. So I told them to
 "look out" for another place with a permanent
 water hole - & I should come back to them. I do
